## How to find the Fade In data folder

Fade In stores some information in a special folder on your computer. This includes things like dictionary files, templates, autosave backups, shortcut key mappings, system reports, and other things (but <u>not</u> document files).

## **Windows**

Press the Windows key, then **R** to show the **Run** window. Then type:

#### **%APPDATA%**

and hit Enter. That will bring up an Explorer window with a number of folders in it. One of them will be called **Fade In**. Double-click on that.

**Note:** %APPDATA% is a shortcut for **C:\Users\< Username>\AppData\Roaming**.

### <u>Mac</u>

From the Finder, choose **Go > Go To Folder**, and type:

~/Library/Application Support/Fade In (don't forget the leading "~")

For the Mac App Store version you'll need to type:

~/.fadein
