Resolution on Windows HiDPI displays

If fonts appear jagged when running on Windows on a HiDPI display, it may be necessary to disable display scaling for Fade In. That can be done by right-clicking on the Fade In icon and choosing **Properties**. Then, in the **Fade In Properties** dialog, uncheck **Disable display scaling on high DPI settings**.
