Enterprise deployment/installation

Windows

Installation on Windows currently uses an executable installer. The installer can be executed from a script, and has a number of switches that can be supplied on the command line, such as: `/SILENT` (or `/VERYSILENT`) and `/SUPPRESSMESSAGEBOXES`.

Mac

The Mac package is distributed as a `.dmg`, and can be mounted from a custom installation script. The application simply needs to be copied to the Applications folder.

Linux

Multiple options are available for Linux installation, including `.deb`, `.rpm`, and basic `.tar.gz` distribution.
